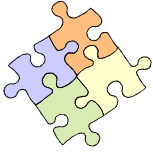

  - c. CSUN Heath and Well-being Fair – Vote to allocate \$200. 4 yeas, 3 nays, 5 abstentions.


- d. **Annual Greek Festival allocation of \$500 for community outreach -- 8 yeas, 1 nay, 1 recusal, 1 abstention.**
